Pre Arrival

- You will have received an email with our Guest Agreement. Please complete this prior to arrival
- Our social distancing and handwashing policies are on line and can be accessed online through the MANAGE MY BOOKING function on the website.

Arrival

- We will leave the cottage open for your arrival. The key will be on the coat rack as you enter the cottage in a sealed bag
- We will have a phone/video call if we have not been on site when you arrive to confirm that everything is ok.
- If we are meeting you on site we will adhere to social distancing protocols
- You have our contact details and we can be contacted at any time.

Communal Areas

Laundry

- 1 person at a time in the laundry room
- Use the hand sanitiser prior to entry and on leaving.
- The area will be disinfected each day during your stay

Outdoor Kitchen

- One household at a time.
- Please leave the area clean and tidy after use
- This area will be cleaned regularly during your stay
- There will be outdoor kitchen cleaning supplies left each house.

Swings and Slide

Bins

- One person at bin area at a time
- Wash your hands after use
- Bins will be disinfected daily

Departure

- Leave the house clean and tidy
- Empty all rubbish in appropriate outside bins
- Strip all bed linen (not the mattress or pillow protectors) and place in plastic bags (supplied)
